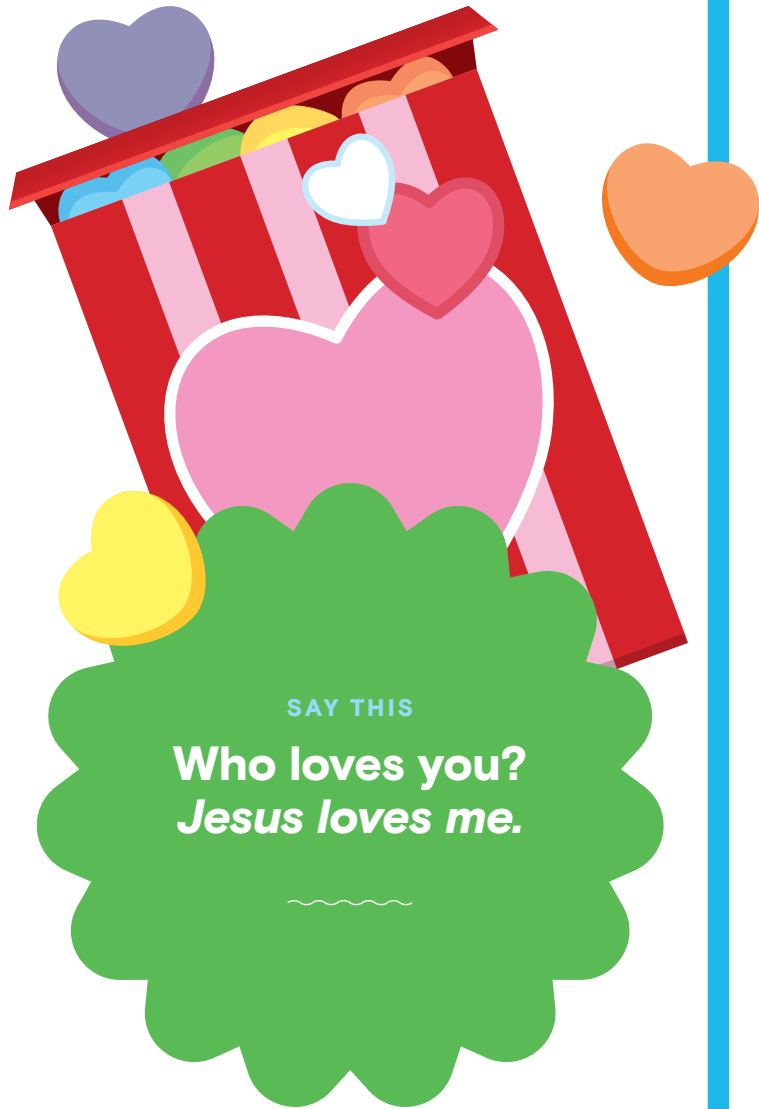


Theme

WEEK 1

When the disciples try to stop children from going to Jesus, Jesus says let the children come to Him.

Luke 18:15-16

Who said to let the children come to Him?
(Jesus)

Does Jesus love children? (Yes)

WEEK 2

Martha becomes frustrated when her sister Mary chooses to listen to Jesus instead of helping her cook and clean.

Luke 10:38-42

What did Martha do when Jesus came to visit?
(cook, clean)

Who wants us to spend time with Him? (Jesus)

WEEK 3

A Centurion (an important leader) asks Jesus to help his servant who is sick, and Jesus makes him all better without even going to his house!

Matthew 8:5-13

Did Jesus have to go to the sick person's house to make them better? (No)

Who loves you and wants to help you? (Jesus)

WEEK 4

A woman shows she is thankful and loves Jesus by washing his feet and using her special perfume.

Luke 7:36-50

Why was the woman thankful? (Because Jesus loved her)

What did the woman put on Jesus' feet?
(Perfume)
