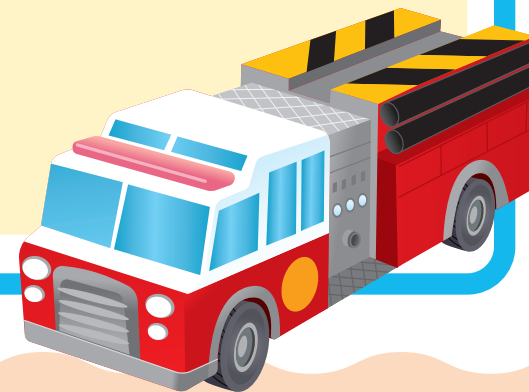

## WEEK 1

**Jesus tells a story about a Samaritan who helps a hurt man on the side of the road.**

Matthew 21:1-11, 15-16

Were the Samaritan man and the hurt man friends? (No)  
Did the Samaritan help the hurt man? (Yes)

## WEEK 2

**Four friends help carry a man to see Jesus because he cannot walk.**

Matthew 26:20-50; 27:1-2; 28:1-7;  
John 13:33; 14:1-3, 28

Why did the four friends carry the man to Jesus? (They believed Jesus could help him.)  
How did Jesus help the man? (Jesus made the man's legs all better.)

## WEEK 3

**Tabitha helps others by making clothes, and Timothy helps others by teaching people about God and showing them how to love like Jesus.**

John 21:1-14

What did Tabitha do to help others? (She made clothes for them.)  
What did Timothy do to help others? (He taught people how to love like Jesus.)

## WEEK 4

**Rebekah looks for a way to help and gives water to a man and all of his camels.**

Matthew 28:19-20

What did the man ask Rebekah to share with him? (Water)  
What else did Rebekah do to help? (She gave water to his ten camels.)
