

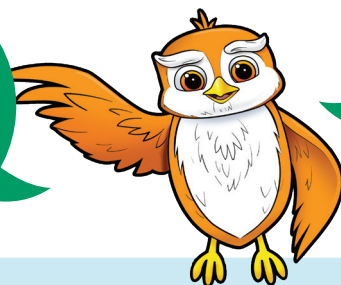

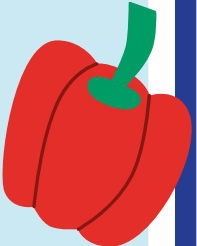
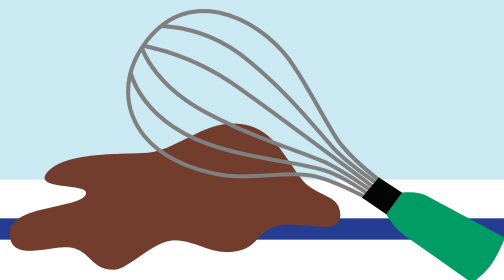
Who made you wonderful?

WEEK 1

WEEK 2

When people create, think, and help, they show they are made in the image of God.

Genesis 1:26-27; Psalms 28:7, 104:24, 121:2; Proverbs 2:6; Acts 17:24

What is your favorite way to create? (Draw, sing, pretend, cook, dress-up, build, paint, etc.)
What are ways you can be helpful?

WEEK 3

God knows you from the inside out, so much so that God even knows how many hairs are on your head.

Psalm 139:1-4; Matthew 10:30

WEEK 4

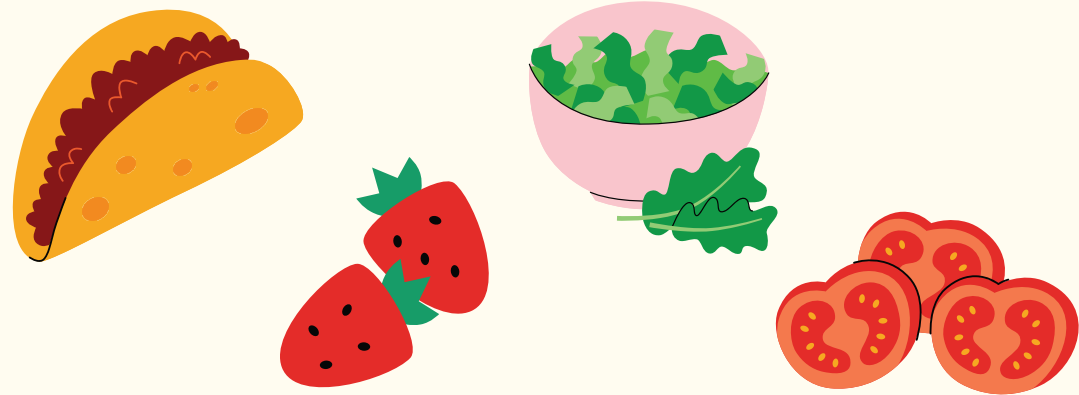

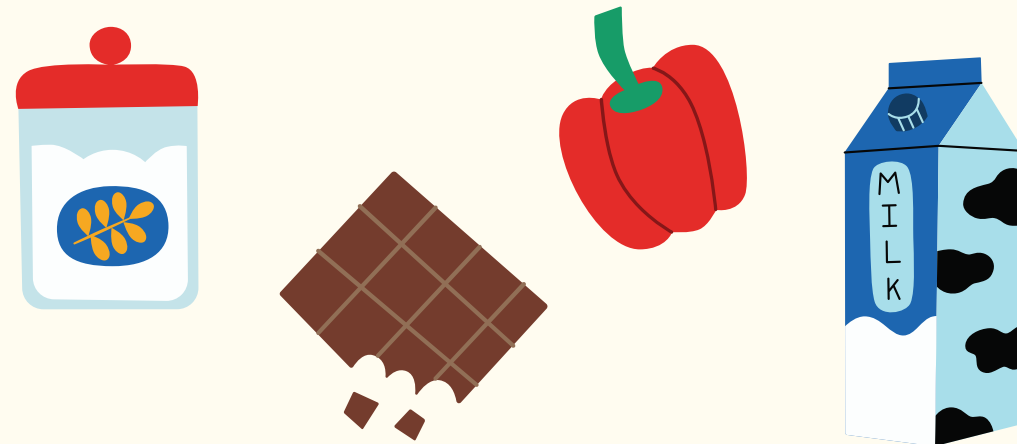
